Our **Featured Speaker** will be **Matt Scott**, aquatic biologist and certified fisheries scientist, retired after 38 years of service in Maine State Government including service as Deputy Commissioner of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, and co-founder of the DEP lakes program in 1970 and the VLMP in 1971. He is a Master Maine Guide and a backyard beekeeper for 50+ years. Matt's topic is "*All lakes are vulnerable, some more than others.*" We've also asked him to be prepared to speak specifically about **metaphyton** ("green cotton candy") for those who may be concerned about this summer phenomenon.
