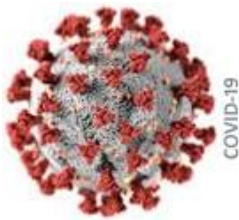




A NOTE ABOUT RWPA'S SUMMER SEASON AND ANNUAL MEETING FOR 2021
