

RWPA Annual Meeting 2022 Quick Summary

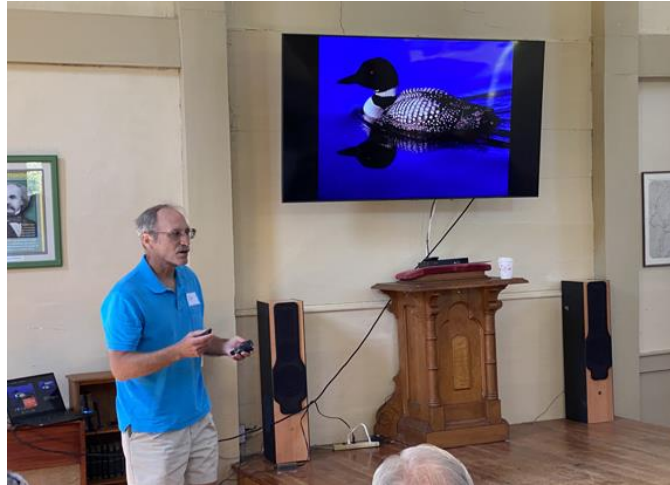
We were pleased to be able to hold RWPA's annual meeting in person once again. It was held at Hawthorne House in Raymond on June 25.
